FROM THE PASTOR...

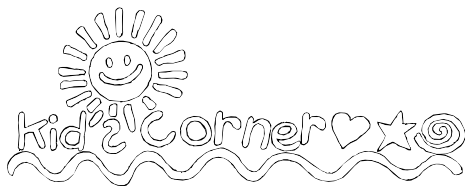

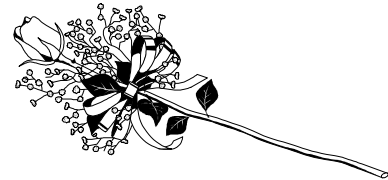


CHAPLAIN (COL) TOM FULLER TO SPEAK
