Saturday, June 9 from 7:00 a.m. till 12:00 p.m.

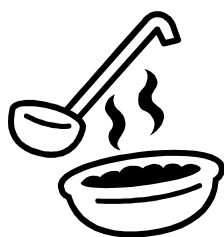
